Camping ministry and Bible camps have been around a long, long time.

As a kid, I attended Bible camp. My parents had been camp counselors and actually met and got engaged while on staff. My grandmother first went to camp as a small child, riding along with her mother who cooked for the first church retreats held on West Lake Okoboji in the 1920s.

My call to be a pastor came while I was a counselor in the same place, some 70 years later. Some of you have similar stories. God has been working in special ways through camps for a very long time.

The Bible is full of such stories. Jesus goes up the mountain to pray.

God speaks to Moses through a burning bush. The wilderness is often a place of searching and spiritual growth. Sacred ground – across the generations.

At Trinity, we encourage our youth and families to attend camp so that they, too, can experience God in new and powerful ways. Last year about 40 Trinity youth and friends went to summer Bible camp with some returning for fall weekend retreats called Recharges.

The stories I hear from parents are proof that God still uses camping ministry to change lives:

- "On the ride home from camp my daughter talked non-stop for two hours!"
- "My son has been reading his Bible every day since he went to camp."
- "My kid came home changed...he's kinder, more respectful and more interested in God and faith."

Trinity's camp scholarship program has been instrumental in creating such experiences. A week at Riverside Bible Camp is \$535/youth. For years, we have offset this cost by up to \$300/youth, enabling far more kids to attend than would otherwise go.

To ensure this can continue, we are launching a special drive to raise \$15,000 for camp scholarships by Easter Sunday 2025. Added to current funds, this should provide enough to cover the next three years of scholarships.

Thanks to a generous lead donor, we have already raised over \$7K toward the \$15K goal! To make a gift, simply write "Camp Scholarships" on your check or envelope. Thanks for helping camps continue to be sacred spaces for God's holy work!



#### Puzzle Palooza










#### **T150**
