





NATHAN ELSBERND: *Pursuing a Career in Music*

Trinity Lutheran Church has been a “second home” for Nathan Elsbernd throughout the years. From watching church organists to feeling nurtured by various mentors and congregation members, he grew up at Trinity with a love of music that only grew stronger with time. Elsbernd is, of course, the son of Becky (Trinity’s Parish Nurse) and Randy Elsbernd, and he is pursuing a career as a church music director.

Currently in his second year at Yale University in a Master of Music program, Elsbernd will graduate in May 2025 with a Master of Music, a Certificate from the Institute of Sacred Music (ISM) and “hopefully a Church Music Certificate from the ISM as well.” He spends his days in classes and playing the

organ for chapel and/or other services. Elsbernd also sings in Schola Cantorum, and mentioned, “One nice thing about the East Coast/Yale is that most of the choirs are paid.” He explained that organists take individual lessons, Liturgical Keyboard Skills, and improv as core classes and they meet once a week as a department to discuss topics or to listen to each other play.

What made him choose this path? So many things... He explained:

I felt a call to “minister to the people” and later decided that that statement could compromise with me and thus I became a church musician. I get to work at the crossroads of many of my interests, the religion classes I took at Luther and the ones I’m taking at Yale were/are so stimulating.

Looking back, this path seems just as much the obvious simple path as it is the difficult and winding path. My parents can attest that I was interested in music as a child. I thought the past organists at Trinity were really cool. I’m thankful that they allowed me to watch them and that they eventually created opportunities for me to learn and gain real-world experience.

I think as a child the organ was fascinating because it had the most buttons of any instrument I had seen! If I am being honest, I desired responsibility and power. I wanted to be important. With so many buttons I thought, ‘I am in charge of a lot!’ Yet, later as I developed as a musician I discovered that I don’t like solo playing; as in I don’t like being the center of attention and I enjoy collaboration and community more than playing in high-pressure concert situations. This focus on people and community ultimately became the reason that I continue doing what I do. I do it because I enjoy what we can do together. I like what we sound like when we sing together.

Sometimes kids want to follow in their parents’ footsteps. Sometimes they don’t. Elsbernd knew that being a Parish Nurse wasn’t in his future and he also fought his desire to follow in his father’s footsteps. He said, “Little did I know that by stuffing my firefighter desires in a box they would come out in a sort of rebellious spurt upon graduating Luther. I spent a summer working as a wildland firefighter for the Bureau of Land Management and then took an EMT class during my first semester at Yale. I think what my dad does is quite interesting and every time I am around him I want to do what he does. Currently, I am not doing anything in this area but every once in a while I still fantasize about returning to it. Needless to say, this path has still impacted my life as a musician and brought me experiences that I wouldn’t have had if I had just stuck to music.”

And then he said something that almost anyone can relate to: “It is both the successes and defeats that shape your path.” Like most of us, Elsbernd has his share of both. Moving to the East Coast brought quite a culture shock, especially living in a large city. He also said he has to keep reminding himself not


to take things personally, because “people are just more direct in their use of language here.” His worst days consist of unrealistic workloads and expectations while his best days are “balanced days” where he doesn’t feel rushed and is “able to get in a bit of everything.” That “everything” includes music practice, academic work, socializing, physical activity (pickleball, running, biking) and rest.

Elsbernd is thankful for the background he received at Trinity. He said, “I am thankful to my many mentors who nurtured me, listened to me, supported me, and created opportunities for me to ‘try the job out.’ I am thankful that so many in the congregation gathered around me to cheer me on. Every artist needs a supportive community and at the early start of my career it was integral to my growth and dedication to the craft.”

He continued: “I am so thankful that I got to play a recital at Trinity this summer. It helped remind me why I’m on this path. I felt supported and encouraged. I enjoyed seeing all the familiar faces again—it felt like having my high school graduation party all over again! Thank you all for filling me up as I begin my final year of grad school.”†

TECH TRAINING INFO

We are in the transition time where Dani Vogel will be taking over coordinating worship technologies and Digital Ministries at Trinity. This includes working with our advisory team, scheduling Tech team for services, and helping with other digital ministry events and activities. We are going to be moving into a new and exciting season with our Worship Technology assistants. We are including a link for a time for folks to attend a digital training session where we will be doing some hands on training with our sound board and video system. We will ask new folks to commit to two Sundays where they

work alongside a seasoned veteran of video or sound, and then have them complete a solo session during a Saturday night service. Following the completion of these trainings, we will begin paying our Worship Technology assistants for their help with our services. Regular Sunday Services will be paid at a rate of \$25.00 per Sunday. This includes arriving at 8:30 AM, completing your task area through service, switching the board over to the 10:30 AM service, and communicating any issues or needs before departing. For Holiday Services, we will pay folks \$35.00 per service worked. These Holidays include the following days, and may be expanded on at the discretion of the church.

- Reformation Sunday
- Christmas Pageant Sunday
- Christmas Eve Services
- Holy Week Services
- Easter Sunday
- Pentecost




